### **Budget Support in Tanzania**

Ten donors, the European Commission and the World Bank are putting 370 million USD into budget support and support credits in 2003/4.

DFID is putting 75% (£60 million) of its budget in Tanzania into budget support.

## **Budget Support raises two relatively new challenges for development cooperation:**

1.We are asking recipient government systems of accountability to satisfy donor systems of accountability.

So, whose role is it to monitor and build the capacity of these systems of accountability in recipient countries?

2. Budget support flows into the recipient governments system of budget frameworks and budget lines.

So, whose role is to learn about this often very complex budgetary system.







FIGURE 3.2.3. Change in use of piped protected, unprotected and other water sources for drinking 1991-2001 from HBS




#### Regional variation in access to improved




