




#### **Early Years**

- 1972: Founded as Action in Distress
- Founded by Cecil Jackson-Cole, a businessman
- He earlier found OXFAM in the 1940s and Helpage in the 1950s
- AID founded as a child sponsorship agency
- Firs projects in India and Kenya
- Assistance to orphans and poor children assess primary education


#### Vision & Mission

- ActionAid's vision is a world without poverty and injustice in which every person can exercise their right to a life of dignity
- ActionAid's mission is to work with poor and excluded people to eradicate poverty and injustice

- Humility


# AA's Distinctive approach

- Using research to develop and promote alternatives




# Areas for emphasis

- Documentation




